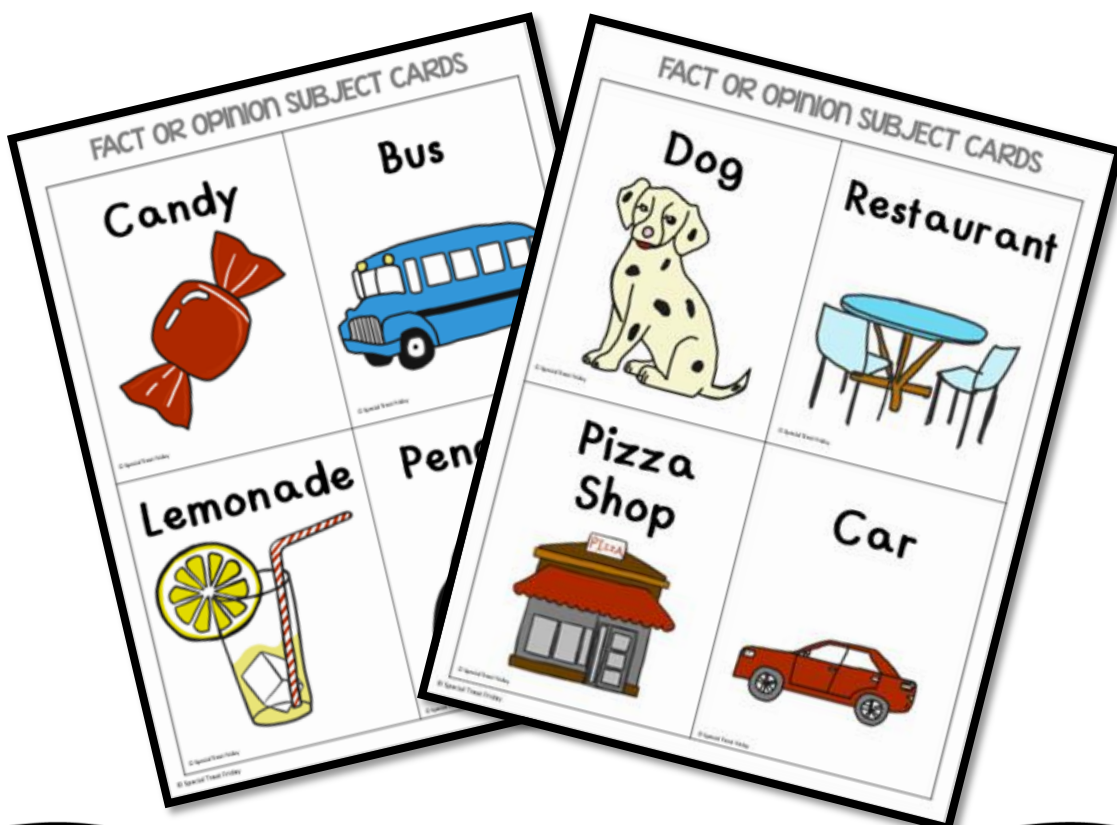


## Fact & Opinion Game

Play a game called "Fact or Opinion". Say a fact or opinion and let the students either write their answer on a personal white board, shout out their answers, work individually or with a partner.

Included in the unit are fact and opinion cards that students can hold up.

This is a good way for the teacher to see if students are grasping this idea.



## Fact vs Opinion Practice

There are a few ways that this can be done.

This Can Be Done

- WHOLE GROUP

- 1 The students can take Fact vs. Opinion cards and sort them. There are heading cards included in the unit.
- 2 Put students into groups and give each group a chart paper. Use the Fact/Opinion statements and larger headers and have the students glue the facts and opinions underneath.
- 3 Once finished the students can share with their group or partner.
- 4 Individually or with a partner, give students the Fact and Opinion Paper sorting paper and give them a sheet of Facts vs. Opinions and have them cut them out and sort them.
